2010 College Scholarship Program

ELIGIBILITY

- ▼ Any high school senior or college student who is employed by a motion picture theatre in the state of Illinois which is a current member of the National Association of Theatre Owners of Illinois, as of January 1, 2010.
- ▼ Applicants must have been employed with a member circuit, in the state of Illinois, for at least one year prior to the application due date, and must have worked an average of 15 hours per week for the previous year (780 hours minimum).

HOW TO APPLY

- ▼ Complete the application form and mail to NATO of Illinois, 603 Rogers Street, Downers Grove, IL 60515-3774. Applications, complete with all related attachments, must be received by March 1, 2010.
NOTE: Many schools require 2-3 weeks to process transcript requests.

- ▼ Only complete applications will be considered.

HOW SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AWARDED

- ▼ A committee of at least 3 NATO of Illinois members will review all applications and select a first, second, third place winner, and an alternate, in case one of the winners does not attend college. In the event the first place winner does not use the scholarship award, the second place winner would receive the higher amount.
- ▼ The criteria used to select winners will be based on grades, work ethic and other information contained in the application.
- ▼ All winners must be enrolled in a college, junior college or university within one calendar year of award notification. Winners must still be employed by a member theatre within one month of scholarship disbursement.
- ▼ Scholarships will be paid directly to the educational institution upon enrollment.
- ▼ Scholarship winners will be announced on or before May 1, 2010.
- ▼ All decisions made by the scholarship committee will be final.
